The petitioner, who joined the respondent-Municipal Council as Clerk in the year 1974, retired on 02.08.2013, on attaining the age of superannuation, has not been paid the retiral benefits.

Contentends that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the ratio of law laid down in ***Punjab State Civil Supplies Corporation Ltd. Vs. Pyare Lal, 2013(1) PLR 36.***

In the circumstances, the competent authority is directed to treat the present petition as representation and decide the same by passing a speaking order, in terms of the law laid down in Pyare Lal's case (supra), within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
