1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

The prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to the respondents to re-consider the claim of the petitioner on the post of Class-III i.e. Lower Division Clerk instead of Class-IV i.e. Peon according to his qualification at Super Thermal Power Plant, Jharli (Jhajjar).

Learned counsel states that in this regard the petitioner has also moved representations and by letter (Annexure P-10) he was informed that the matter is still pending with the respondent No.1. He further states that he would be satisfied at this stage if in the first instance a direction is issued to the respondent No.1 to decide the same by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. Resultantly, the respondent No.1 is directed to decide the claim of the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
