Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied, at this stage, if a direction is issued to the respondents to take a decision on the representation made by the petitioner on 13.08.2014, a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-2 with the petition, within a specified period.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents to take a decision on the aforesaid representation, by passing a speaking order within a period of 2 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

In case the claim of the petitioner, or any part thereof, is found due, the same shall be released to him, within a period of 2 months thereafter.

However, of course, if for any legally valid reason, the relief sought by the petitioner, or any part thereof, is not found due, such reasons for denial thereof, shall be given in the speaking order to be passed.
