AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is apparent from the earlier order dated 18.09.2014 (Annexure P-4), which has been passed by this Court in Civil Writ Petition No.15753 of 2014 (M/s Truck Union Moga and others Vs. State of Punjab and others), that there are inter-se disputes/litigation between the members of the petitioner-Union. This writ petition, primarily, deals with such a situation where again a dispute has emanated between the members of the Union for which the petitioner-Union may avail of its remedy in accordance with law as these disputed questions of facts cannot be gone into in the writ petition.

The writ petition, therefore, stands dismissed.
