AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of counsel for the petitioners that the impugned order dated 18.02.2014 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Assistant Collector Ist Grade-Naib Tehsildar, Baba Bakala, is not sustainable and while highlighting the illegalities therein, the petitioners have served a legal notice dated 02.10.2014 (Annexure P-8) upon the respondents but till date no decision thereon has been taken or conveyed to the petitioners.

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Assistant Collector Ist Grade-Naib Tehsildar, Baba Bakala, District Amritsar-respondent No.4 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 02.10.2014 (Annexure P-8) served by the petitioners, within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners and without going into the merit of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Assistant Collector Ist Grade-Naib Tehsildar, Baba Bakala, District Amritsar-respondent No.4 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 02.10.2014 (Annexure P-8) within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioners.
