By way of this writ petition, the petitioners have challenged the order (Annexure P-10). The case of the petitioners is that they were eligible for promotion and were being considered for the same. However, respondent No.4 filed a civil suit claiming certain reliefs which, as per counsel for the petitioners, were not directly against the petitioners. In that suit, the petitioners were not party. During the pendency of that suit, as per counsel for the petitioners, the Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Sirsa has passed an interim order which prejudicially affects the petitioners, and it is that order which has been challenged in the present writ petition.

In my considered opinion, this mode of challenging a judicial

order by an independent writ petition is highly misconceived. It is not disputed that the petitioners can move an application for impleadment before the civil Court in the said civil suit and raise the same pleas as are being raised in this writ petition. Consequently, finding no merit in this writ petition, the same is dismissed.
