The petitioners seek counting of service rendered by them on *ad hoc* basis, towards the pensionary benefits. The learned counsel cites ***Kesar Chand Vs. State of Punjab and others, 1988(5) SLR 27; Bidhi Chand Vs. State of Punjab, 1999(1) SCT 481; and Joginder Singh Vs. State of Haryana, 1998(1) SCT 795.***

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of their grievance, the petitioners have served a legal notice, Annexure P-6, however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to decide the legal notice, Annexure P-6, in the light of the case law cited by the learned counsel for the petitioners, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
