Counsel for the petitioner has argued that certain information was not given to the petitioner by the PIO. He filed a representation to the appellate Authority but the same was not decided. Thereafter, he served a legal notice (Annexure P-8) and that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice within a reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice (Annexure P-8) of the petitioner, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order, within a period of one month from the receipt of a certified copy of this order.
