The three Elected Panches along with two residents of village Assankala, Tehsil and District Panipat are seeking a Mandamus to the Deputy Commissioner, Panipat for taking action under Section 51 of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 (for short the '1994 Act') against Sajjan Singh, Sarpanch (respondent no.6) for his acts of embezzlement of Panchayat Funds.

At the time of hearing learned Counsel for the petitioners has not disputed that regular enquiry under Section 51 of the 1994 Act has already been entrusted to the Additional Deputy Commissioner, Panipat and the same is under progress. In fact one of the Annexure P-5 reveals that a detailed statement of the Gram *Sachiv* has been got recorded on 31.12.2014.

Therefore, the primary grievance raised in the petition stands already redressed. We can only hope that the conclusion of the enquiry is expedited.

At this stage on instructions from his client learned Counsel for the Petitioners prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
