**INDERJIT SINGH, J.**

Appellant-claimant Anil Kumar has preferred the instant appeal against Shakir-driver of offending truck bearing registration No.HR-69-C-0081, Anurag and Future General India Insurance Company Limited-insurer of the said offending Truck, challenging the impugned award dated 31.08.2010, passed by the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Narnaul, (herein referred as 'Tribunal'), for enhancement of compensation, which was awarded by the Tribunal.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3-Insurance Company has stated that their company is ready to pay ₹ 1,00,000/- to the claimant in lump-sum within 30 days from today. Learned counsel for the appellant-claimant has agreed to the statement made by learned counsel for respondent No.3-Insurance Company and has prayed that the instant appeal be disposed of accordingly as per the statement of learned counsel for respondent No.3-Insurance Company.

In view of the aforesaid statements, made by learned counsel for the parties, this appeal is disposed of by enhancing the compensation to ₹1,00,000/- in lump sum which is to be deposited by the Insurance Company before the learned Tribunal within 30 days from today, for disbursement to the claimant. If respondent No.3- Insurance Company fails to deposit the enhanced amount within 30 days then the appellant-claimant shall be entitled to interest @ 7.5% from the date of claim petition till actual realization.
