Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the fact that the charges against the petitioner were dropped, finding him completely innocent, vide order dated 26.08.2014 (Annexure P-6), certain dues have not been paid to him, in respect of which a legal notice, dated 19.11.2014, is stated to have been served upon the 1st respondent, a copy of which is annexed with the petition as Annexure P-8.

Learned counsel further submits that, at this stage, a direction may be issued to the respondents to take a decision on the aforesaid legal notice, within a specified time frame.

This petition is, consequently, disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 1, to take a decision on the aforesaid legal notice, within a period of 2 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, by passing a speaking order.

In case the petitioner is found entitled to the benefits claimed, the same shall be released to him within two months thereafter, along with interest @ 8% per annum, from the date that such benefits accrued to him, till the date that actual payment is made to him.

If, however, for any **legally valid reasons**, the benefits, or any part thereof, are not found due, detailed reasons for the same, would be given in the speaking order to be passed.
