This order will dispose of two writ petitions bearing No.5126 and 20878 of 2015 as per detailed order of even date passed in a connected case i.e. CWP No.24603 of 2015 tilted as '**Harpreet Singh & ors. v. State of Punjab & ors.**' Both the petitions are disposed of in the same terms without awaiting the reply of the State of Punjab. Mr. Inqulab Nagpal makes no grievance on this score since the decision making as a result of the directions in the aforesaid orders still remains with the State Government to be decided in the light of the precedents on the subject, in order not to waste the further time of the Court on a matter

which is eminently covered by the dicta and directions, and to accordingly facilitate justice without delay both the petitions are disposed of in terms of the decision rendered in **CWP No.22478 of 2015** titled as “**Gurmeet Singh & ors. v. State of Punjab & ors.**”, decided on October 19, 2015 together with other connected cases disposed of by a common order.

With the above observations and directions, these petitions are disposed of with the direction to the respondents to act in conformity with the directions issued in *Gurmeet Singh's case (supra)* and within the time frame as fixed today while disposing of CWP No.24603 of 2015.
