The only prayer made in this petition is for demarcation of the agricultural land of the petitioner.

The respondents have filed their reply along with the demarcation report. According to the respondents, the demarcation has been conducted on 22.04.2015 in the presence of the police personnel. It is further submitted that since the demarcation of the agricultural land of the petitioner has already been carried out, therefore, this petition has become infructuous.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and examining the available record especially the reply filed by respondents No.1 to 4 and the demarcation report attached thereto, I am of the considered opinion that since the prayer made by the petitioner has already been granted by the respondents, therefore, the present petition has become infructuous.
