The five petitioners by filing the present writ petition are seeking a direction to the Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana not to demolish their houses without issuing of the mandatory notice as per Section 269 of the Punjab Municipal Corporation Act, 1976.

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner it is apparent that the provisions of Section 269 of the Punjab Municipal Corporation Act, 1976 related to unauthorised constructions over land owned by the occupants whereas no such procedure is contemplated for removal of encroachments. If the occupants have encroached upon public lands, then for their removal and demolition of their structures, different procedure is contemplated.

At this stage learned Counsel for the petitioners prays for permission to withdraw the present writ petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
