DEEPAK SIBAL, J. :

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, he would be satisfied if the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no. 2 to take a decision on the legal notice dated 15.09.2014 (Annexure P-7), issued by the learned counsel for the petitioner. I find the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner to be reasonable.

the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no. 2 to take decision on the legal notice dated 15.09.2014 (Annexure P-7), issued by the learned counsel for the petitioner, by passing a speaking order, preferably within four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Needless to add that the decision so taken be communicated to the petitioner and if the decision is not to the satisfaction of the petitioner, he would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.
