Hemant Gupta, J.

The petitioner responded to the advertisement dated 25.12.2014 inviting bids for Handling and Transport Contractors and Road Transport Contractors. Technical bid of the petitioner has been found to be not conforming the norms fixed in the notice inviting tender that experience certificate was not in a prescribed format.

Such issue has been examined by the Division Bench of this Court in CWP No. 717 of 2015 (R.S. Labour and Transport Contractor versus Food Corporation of India and others) wherein it has been held that experience certificate is not required to be in the format if the information is otherwise available in the documents filed.

However, learned counsel for the respondents points out that tender in which the petitioner submitted his technical bid has

been scraped and fresh tenders have been invited for which the last date for furnishing bids is 12.05.2015.

In view of the said fact, the present writ petition is dismissed as infructuous. The petitioner may submit its bid in accordance with law to the advertisement already issued.
