AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners have approached this Court with a grievance that their life and liberty is in danger as their parents-respondents 4 to 6 are not agreeable to their relationship, which they want to materialize through marriage. They are at present residing together. They state that the respondents would harm/endorse their life by taking law in their own hands and, therefore, apprehending danger to them, they had submitted representation for protection of their life and liberty to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, on 17.03.2015 (Annexure P-5).

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, to consider and take appropriate steps in accordance with law on the representation dated 17.03.2015 (Annexure P-5) submitted by them, within some specified time.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Senior

Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, to consider the representation of the petitioners dated 17.03.2015 (Annexure P-5) and if there appears to be any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners, appropriate steps, in accordance with law, be taken for protection thereof.

Copy of the order be given *dasti* to counsel for the petitioners under signatures of the Bench Secretary of this Court.
