By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks directions to the respondents to count the service rendered by the petitioner in Govt. Aided School as qualifying service towards the pensionary benefits and for all other consequential benefits.

The learned counsel contends that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered vide judgment of this Court rendered in CWP No. 16817 of 2007 dated 22.07.2009 (Annexure P-3) and in CWP No. 4782 of 2009 dated 27.11.2009 (Annexure P-4).

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to consider and examine the claim of the petitioner in the light of Annexure P-3 and Annexure P-4, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
