After addressing arguments for some time and when faced with a query that the petitioner has an efficacious alternative remedy of filing a petition under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 (as applicable to the State of Haryana) (hereinafter referred to as the “1961 Act”), counsel for the petitioner prays that the writ petition may be dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to file a petition under Section 7 of the 1961 Act.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed.

In case, a petition is filed under Section 7 of the 1961 Act, it shall be considered and decided within three months of its filing.
