Writ in the nature of mandamus is prayed for, directing the respondents to release the benefits under the Assured Career Progression Scheme, that had become due to the petitioner. It is maintained that prior to the institution of this petition, petitioner had expressed his grievance on-line, vide communication dated 18.11.2014 (Annexure P-1) to the

respondents, followed by a comprehensive representation dated

25.11.2014 (Annexure P-2), but the same failed to evoke any response.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition, at this stage, be disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner within a stipulated period of time.

That being so, and without expressing any opinion on merits, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner, as set out in the representation dated 25.11.2014 (Annexure P-2), strictly in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to assert, a comprehensive order shall be passed, assigning reasons in support of the decision arrived at.
