The petitioner seeks direction to the respondents to count the past service of the petitioner rendered by him with Haryana Tanneries Ltd. w.e.f. 05.05.1977 to 30.11.1988, towards qualifying service for the purposes of pension and other pensionary benefits.

At the very outset, the learned counsel for the respondent submits that tendering of CPF amount is pre-requisite for consideration of the case of the petitioner for counting of his past service towards pension. The petitioner has not yet deposited the amount.

In view of the above and keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, the same is disposed of with a direction that in case, the petitioner tenders the amount of CPF drawn by him from the earlier employer, i.e. Haryana Tanneries Ltd., within one month from the date

of receipt of certified copy of this order, the case of the petitioner for counting of his earlier service from 05.05.1977 to 30.11.1988 with the Haryana Tanneries Ltd. towards pension etc., be considered in accordance with law and consequential order be passed within four months thereafter.
