DEEPAK SIBAL, J.

Through the present writ petition, the petitioner challenges his transfer from Amritsar to Attari. The basic reliance is on a circular dated 05.09.2012 (Annexure P-7) of respondent No.1-The Central Warehousing Corporation (hereinafter referred to as the 'Corporation') to say that no transfer can be effected when an employee has less than two years of service before his retirement.

I have seen the impugned order and find that the same is only a local arrangement within the same district. The distance between Amritsar and Attari is about 20 Kilometers only and that the petitioners has been transferred there due to an administrative arrangement. An order of transfer can be interfered with if perversity or malafide is shown which is not the case in the present petition. So far as, the reliance on the circular dated

05.09.2012 (Annexure P-7) is concerned, this circular would not apply to such local arrangement as has been done in the case of the petitioner. Even otherwise, the circulars of such nature are only guidelines and cannot be enforced as a matter of right.

Dismissed.
