HEMANT GUPTA, J.

The present writ petition seeks directions to the respondents to make the side/bank of the canal as *pacca* so that the land of the petitioner is not flooded with over flow of the water of the canal.

In the written statement, it has been averred that as the land of the petitioners falls between the Western Jamuna Canal and service road of the canal and that some time the water enters in the fields of the petitioners during the rainy season. In order to avoid the entry of the canal water scouring the fields of petitioners, the department provides temporary protection during those particulars days when there is excessive water in the canal. It is also pointed out that now the department is proposing to provide protection to the land of the petitioners by providing bricks-bat spur at RD 78060, 78160 and 78260 of Western Jamuna Canal and Main Line

Lower. It is also pointed out that the tender rate was approved by

Superintending Engineer on 29.07.2015 and acceptance letter of the work has been issued to the contractor on 30.07.2015. It is also pointed out that there is also silting problem in the canal and de-silting work is likely to be done in near future.

In view of the averments made in the written statement, we do not find that any further directions are required to be issued to the respondents. However, the respondents shall abide by the averments made in the written statement and take appropriate steps as contemplated therein.
