ARUN PALLI, J.(ORAL):-

After having argued the matter at some length, learned Senior counsel for the petitioners submits that prior to the institution of this petition, the petitioners had represented to the respondents, vide representations dated 13.03.2015 (Annexure P12 and P13), but to no avail.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that, at this stage, let this petition be disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.3 and 4, to consider and decide their representation, within a stipulated period of time.

That being so, and, without expressing any opinion on the merits, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.3 and 4, to consider and decide the claim of the petitioners as set out in the representation dated 13.03.2015 (Annexure P12), strictly, in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to assert, a comprehensive order shall be passed assigning reasons, in support of the decision arrived at.

The petition stands disposed of.
