AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed by the petitioner challenging the order whereby his services were terminated. The petitioner was appointed as a Constable General Duty in the respondent-Force and joined as such on 5.4.2010. On 4.5.2010 he deserted the camp and left. On 15.5.2010 a notice was issued to him to report for duty but he did not report again. An FIR was also lodged against him for having deserted. Subsequently by order Annexure P-1 dated 4.6.2010 his services were terminated in terms of proviso to sub rule(1) of Rule 5 of the Central Civil Services(Temporary Service) Rules, 1965. After 4 years he filed an appeal which was dismissed on the ground of delay.

I find no reason to take a different view.

Petition is dismissed.
