AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

By this petition the petitioner has challenged the appointment of the respondent No.4 as a Lambardar.

Learned counsel has argued that the authorities below have not considered the fact that a criminal case stands registered against the respondent No.4 and that he being a contractor is not available in the village.

It may be noticed that the Collector, Commissioner and the Financial Commissioner have all considered the cases of all the candidates and have all found that respondent No.4 was the most appropriate candidate.

In the circumstances, no ground for interference is made out.

Petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
