The petitioner is a resident of Khanna, Punjab and is seeking a direction to the Municipal Committee, Khanna for removal of encroachments from Guru Amar Dass Market, Kanail Singh Road, Khanna by the various shopkeepers including the verandahs encroached upon.

Upon notice, the parties had entered appearance through their respective Counsel.

On the previous date of hearing i.e. 11.09.2014, learned Counsel for the Municipal Committee, Khanna had stated that all the encroachments had been removed from Subhash Bazaar.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner was directed to file an affidavit as to whether any encroachment still remained to be removed.

At the time of hearing today, an affidavit dated 26.03.2015 of the petitioner-Kirpal ingh has been filed stating that all the permanent encroachments, as claimed in the petition, have since been removed. The affidavit is taken on record.

Hence, the present writ petition is disposed of.

It is hoped that no future encroachments of permanent nature shall be permitted lest the official concerned are made personally liable to face the consequences of such encroachments.
