The petitioner has challenged the order Annexure P-6, *inter alia*, on the ground that respondent No.4 has not followed the principle of natural justice, inasmuch, the opportunity of hearing was not given.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for respondent No.2 to 4 has submitted that the petitioner may approach the concerned authority (respondent No.4) within a week with his representation, which shall be decided by the said authority (respondent No.4) within a week thereafter. Needless to say that the petitioner would also be afforded personal hearing in

support of his representation and respondent No.4 then shall pass a speaking order in accordance with law.

It is made clear that while passing the order, respondent No.4 shall not be influenced by the earlier order passed by him.

With these observations, the present petition is hereby disposed of.
