1. Notice of motion.
2. Ms. Palika Monga, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1. Let two sets of the paper-book be supplied to her during the course of the day.
3. In this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the amount of compensation of her acquired land as per the award dated 25.6.2004 (Annexure P-7) along with interest.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that for the relief claimed in the writ petition, the petitioner has moved a representation dated 30.10.2014 (Annexure P-10) to respondent No.2, but no action has so far been taken thereon.
5. After hearing learned counsel for the parties, perusing the

present petition and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, we dispose of the present petition by directing respondent No.2 to take a decision on the representation dated 30.10.2014 (Annexure P-10), in accordance with law by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. It is further directed that in case it is found that the petitioner is entitled to the amount of compensation, the same be paid to her along with interest forthwith.
