Writ in the nature of certiorari is prayed for, to quash the order dated 05.03.2012 (Annexure P3), passed by respondent No.4, vide which the claim of the petitioner for appointment to a Class IV post on compassionate ground has been declined. It is averred that apparently the said order does not assign any reason and is, thus, unsustainable. It is maintained that prior to the institution of this petition, petitioner had served upon the respondents a legal notice dated 27.10.2014 (Annexure P7) and pursuant thereto, vide letter dated 17.11.2014 (Annexure P8), respondent No.1 has directed to respondent No.2 i.e. Director Public Instructions (SE), Punjab, to take an immediate decision vis-à-vis the claim of the petitioner. But to no avail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the claim of the petitioner is still pending consideration before respondent No.2, let this petition, at this stage, be disposed of with a direction to the said respondent to consider and decide his legal notice within a stipulated period of time by passing a speaking order.

That being so, and without expressing any opinion on merits, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner, as set out in the legal notice dated 27.10.2014 (Annexure P7), strictly in accordance with law, within two months from the receipt of certified copy of this order. Needless to assert, a comprehensive order shall be passed, assigning reasons in support of the decision arrived at.
