It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has submitted an application for issuance of an arms license on 18.02.2014 (Annexure P-1). The same was duly processed. The Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad, vide report dated 25.08.2014 (Annexure P-4), has recommended the issuance of the arms license to the petitioner but despite the said report, The Deputy Commissioner, Fatehabad, who is the competent authority under the Arms Act, 1959, has not taken a final decision upon the application of the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Deputy Commissioner, Fatehabad-respondent No. 2 to consider and decide the application of the petitioner dated 18.02.2014 (Annexure P-1) within some specified time.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Deputy Commissioner, Fatehabad-respondent No. 2 to consider and decide the application of the petitioner dated 18.02.2014 (Annexure P-1) within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
