RAJIVE BHALLA, J.

The petitioner prays for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing respondent no. 3 not to change the ownership of Shamlat land and as an alternative prays that Municipal Council, Nawanshahar should be directed to desist from using the common land of the village as a dumping ground.

Counsel for the Municipal Council submits that the land has come to vest in the Municipal Council, pursuant to a notification issued under the Punjab Municipal Act, 1911 and they do not intend to use the land in dispute, as a dumping

ground.

Counsel for the State of Punjab submits that requisite mutation has been sanctioned in favour of the Municipal Council, Nawanshahar.

Faced with the aforesaid statement, counsel for the petitioner prays that he may be allowed to withdraw the writ petition to enable the petitioner to seek his remedy in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed.
