It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that the claim of the petitioner for appointment on compassionate grounds has been duly processed and is pending with the Director, Education Department (Senior Secondary), Punjab-respondent No.2, but no decision thereon has been taken. Counsel contends that the petitioner has served a legal notice dated 17.10.2014 (Annexure P-6) upon the respondents but that also has not solicited any response. He further contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Director, Education Department (Senior Secondary), Punjab-respondent No.2, to consider and decide the legal notice of the petitioner dated 17.10.2014 (Annexure P-6), within some specified time.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Director, Education Department (Senior Secondary), Punjab-respondent No.2, to consider and decide the legal notice dated 17.10.2014

(Annexure P-6), within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by passing a speaking order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, further steps, in accordance with law, be initiated forthwith.
