The petitioner questions the permission granted by the Director General, Town and Country Planning, Haryana-respondent No.2 in favour of respondent No.3, who is developer.

2. According to the petitioner, the permissions seriously prejudiced his rights in respect of his property. It is *inter alia*, contended that the permissions have been granted on the basis of his property. Therefore, implementation of any work pursuant to the permissions affect his rights. The petitioner has in fact alleged forgery by respondent No.3 and collusion between the respondents inter se. It is not necessary for us to consider any of these allegations in this writ petition.

3. The petitioner has merely sought an order directing respondent No.2 to consider his representation at Annexures P-11, P-13 and P-14 dated 04.10.2012, 28.12.2012 and 05.08.2013 respectively. The petitioner has also sought an enquiry into the alleged fraud. We do not intend considering the second relief at this stage.

4. The writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and process the aforesaid representations of the petitioner by 31.08.2015. The petitioner is also at liberty to seek the other relief in fresh proceedings, if adopted. Any action taken by the respondents in the meanwhile shall be without claiming any equities.
