Counsel for the petitioners, after arguing for some time, prays for withdrawal of the writ petition with liberty to approach the Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar-respondent No.2, by way of representation highlighting therein the benefits, the respondents would have gained in case the work would have continued in the same manner as it was being performed for the last two years with regard to P.E.G. godowns. He further states that although the order indicates that it is an interim arrangement and purely temporary in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case but the petitioners would suffer an irreparable loss as it is not that there is any complaint against the working of the petitioners. He further states that the said representation will be filed within a period of one week from today, which may be directed to be considered and decided at an early date.

Without going into merits of the case or commenting therein, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file a detailed representation to the Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar-respondent

No.2, within a period of one week from today. If such a representation is made, the same shall be considered and decided by the Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar-respondent No.2 at an early date, preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of such representation. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioners forthwith.

Copy of this order be given *dasti* to counsel for the petitioners under signatures of Bench Secretary of this Court.
