AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that the service book of the petitioner has not been completed. The petitioner, since 2006, has not been granted any increment nor any benefit has been conferred on him which he is entitled to. He has approached the respondents for the grant of benefit as has been claimed by him in the present writ petition and for the said purpose has also served legal notice dated 26.10.2014 (Annexure P-4) through counsel which till date has not been responded.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if direction is issued to the Director, Education Department (Secondary Education), Punjab-respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 26.10.2014 (Annexure P-4) served by the petitioner within some specified time.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the

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petitioner, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with direction to the Director, Education Department (Secondary Education), Punjab-respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 26.10.2014 (Annexure P-4) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits be released to him, in accordance with law, within a further period of two months. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
