The respondents rightly rejected the petitioner's tender as non-responsive on the ground that the petitioner did not have the requisite qualifications. The petitioner relied upon a certificate of experience which related only to de-silting work in an escape channel. The work experience required by the NIT was with respect to earth work and not de-silting. Moreover, the NIT required the experience to be during a particular period. The certificate relied upon by the petitioner does not even mention the period for which the work was done. This is assuming that the certificate was in fact forwarded alongwith the petitioner's bid.

The work experience appears to be an essential term of the tender.

In these circumstances, the petition is dismissed.
