By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks directions to the respondents to release pensionary benefits of her husband.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of her grievance, the petitioner had served legal notice dated 22.05.2014 (Annexure P-12), however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, which is stated to be respondent No.1, to decide the legal notice, Annexure P-12, in terms of Annexures P-4 to P-10 and in terms of the citations referred in the legal notice (Annexure P-12), by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
