DEEPAK SIBAL, J.

Vide order dated 11.01.2013, the petitioner who was serving as Medical Officer at Civil Dispensary, Mathura Colony, Patiala, was sent on deputation as Medical Officer, Health, Municipal Corporation, Patiala. The borrowing Department i.e. Municipal Corporation, Patiala as also the Department of Local Bodies, Punjab, did not approve the posting of the petitioner on deputation in the Municipal Corporation, Patiala. As a result, thereof, vide order dated 19.03.2015 (Annexure P-11) addressed to the Principal Secretary, Department of Health and Family Welfare, Punjab, respondent No.3 had relieved the petitioner from his duties and sent him back to Principal Secretary, Department of Health and Family Welfare, Punjab. It is this order against which petitioner has approached this Court through the present writ petition.

No employee can seek to be sent on deputation without the
consent of both the lending and the borrowing Department.

On the facts of the case above, it is clear that the borrowing department has not approved the deputation of the petitioner. Thus, the petitioner has no right to continue on deputation.

Resultantly, finding no merit in the writ petition, the same is ordered to be dismissed.
