Learned counsel for the petitioner states that against the order of dismissal, the petitioner has submitted an appeal (Annexure P-11) to respondent No.2, but the same has not been decided even after the passage of a long time.

In view of the above, at this stage, I do not wish to interfere in the present writ petition being premature. However, I deem it proper to issue directions to respondent No.2 to decide the appeal filed by the petitioner (Annexure P-11) expeditiously, by passing a speaking order and after giving opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, preferably within four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Needless to add that the decision so taken be communicated to the petitioner and if the decision is not to the satisfaction of the petitioner, he would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.
