The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the retiral benefits to the petitioner who retired on 30.09.2010 along with interest @ 12% p.a. in view of judgements passed by this Court which are annexed as Annexures P-4, P-5 and P-7 as well as judgement dated 31.01.2006 passed by Hon'ble the Supreme Court which is annexed as Annexure P-11 with the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the decision dated 25.09.2013 of this Court passed

in **CWP No.861 of 2012 titled as 'S.N. Aggarwal vs. Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited and others'**(Annexure P-4) and order passed in **CWP No.4631 of 2008 titled as Ratti Ram vs. UHBVN and others** (Annexure P-5). Learned counsel also submits that the petitioner has made representation dated 04.08.2013 which are annexed as Annexure P-2 with the petition but no action has been taken there upon.

Learned counsel for the respondents has not disputed the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of submission made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider his representation(Annexure P-2) in view of judgements passed by this Court which are annexed as Annexures P-4 and P-5. In case, the petitioner is found entitled for the same relief as granted in the aforesaid judgements, the necessary payment be made to the petitioner within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
