1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?
2. To be referred to the Reporters or not?
3. Whether the judgment should be reported in the Digest?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

The petitioner joined on 7.7.2000 and right from the time of his first posting w.e.f. 17.2.2002 till 8.7.2010 he was posted in a hard area. On 8.7.2010 he was sent to easy area i.e. Group Centre, Pinjore where he was posted till 27.04.2013. Thereafter he was sent to another hard posting in Liberia where it is stated that he was posted at Jabeduru which was a combat zone. On return from Liberia and its hard posting he was again transferred to 178 Battalion which is again a hard posting. In this connection the petitioner is stated to have made representations Annexures P-3 and P-5. Learned counsel states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide his representations in accordance with the policy and

law by passing a speaking order thereon and, till then to keep the impugned order in abeyance.

I find this to be a fair request.

Resultantly this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the said representations in accordance with law and as per policy by passing a speaking order and till then to keep the posting order in abeyance.

Since the main case has been decided, the Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
