1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

The petitioners have been regularised as Kamdar and have been given the grade pay of Rs.1650/-. Learned counsel has argued that one Pal Singh who was also given regular post as a Kamdar by the same order has been granted the higher pay scale of Rs.2400/- Learned counsel states that the petitioners have moved representation Annexure P-5 to the respondent No.2 and that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the said respondent to decide their representation by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request.

Resultantly this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation (Annexure P-5) of the petitioners within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order by passing a speaking order thereon and in case the petitioners are found entitled to any amount as per the relief claimed, to release the same to them within a period of two months thereafter, failing which the petitioners would be entitled to claim the same along with interest at the rate of 8% p.a. from the date/s the amount/s fell due.

Since the main case has been decided, the Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
