AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was allotted the work vide letter dated 18.06.2014 in pursuance to the tender dated 23.05.2014. The said work was estimated to be amounting to ₹14,84,367/-. On completion of the part work, the petitioner submitted his bills to the respondents, as the work was stopped by the order passed by the Sub Divisional Officer. The amount due to the petitioner is ₹3,68,000/- and an amount of ₹71,820/- totalling ₹4,39,820/-. A representation dated 29.02.2014 (Annexure P-2) was submitted by the petitioner, which has till date not been responded to.

Counsel contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Executive Engineer (Civil), Punjab Mandi Board, Sri Muktsar Sahib-respondent No.3, to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 29.09.2014 (Annexure P-2), within some specified time.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the the Executive Engineer (Civil), Punjab Mandi Board, Sri Muktsar Sahib-respondent No.3, to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 29.09.2014 (Annexure P-2), within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits, if any, be released to him, in accordance with law, within a further period of six weeks. In case the claim of the petitioner is not to be accepted, a well reasoned and speaking order be passed and conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
