By way of the instant writ petition, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the official respondents to take legal action against private respondents under the provisions of Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, 1995 and to lodge an FIR against committing an offence of fraud, theft of earth of village Panchayat.

The learned counsel contends that respondent Nos. 7 to 10 in collusion with each other allegedly removed earth from the gram panchayat land. Despite the repeated representations by the petitioner, no action has been initiated by respondent Nos. 3 to 5.

Keeping in view the assertion raised, without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 to look into the complaint filed by the petitioner and take necessary action as per law, within four weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
