Through the present writ petition, petitioner seeks direction to the respondents to count the service rendered by him in Government Aided School for the purpose of qualifying service towards the pensionary benefits of the petitioner after his retirement, in view of the law laid down by this Court in ***CWP No.14238 of 1991*** titled as '***Sukhdev Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others***' decided on ***10.03.2010***.

The short reply has been filed on behalf of the respondents. The order dated 11.09.2015 passed by the District Education Officer (S.E) Amritsar has been appended as Annexure R-1.

As per the said order the service rendered by the petitioner for the actual period from 26.07.1969 to 22.08.1973 in Gyan Ashram Senior Secondary School, outside Chattiwind Gate, Amritsar has been treated as 'qualifying service' for computing pensionary benefits, subject to certain conditions.

Accordingly, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

However, counsel for the petitioner submits that the consequential benefits which are due be paid within a time bound period.

Said request is justified. Accordingly, whatever benefits which have accrued from the said order dated 11.09.2015 shall be paid to the petitioner within a period of 3 months from the receipt of the certified copy of this order.
