Vide order dated 31.3.2015, this Court had directed Mr.Shashank Anand, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Rohtak to remain present in Court on the premise that the impugned order dated 17.3.2015 rejecting the reply of the petitioner was not only non-speaking but cryptic and also suffered from lack of application of mind.

Mr.Shashank Anand, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Rohtak, who is present in Court, assures the Court that in case opportunity is given, he will pass a detailed, reasoned and speaking order.

The impugned order dated 17.3.2015 (Annexure P-21) is hereby set-aside. The Superintendent of Police, Rohtak shall decide the

representation of the petitioner by considering the reply submitted in response to the show cause notice dated 27.1.2015 in a most reasoned manner.

It is expected that the Superintendent of Police, Rohtak shall pass the speaking order by taking into consideration all the points raised by the petitioner in accordance with law.

The order of interim stay shall remain in force till the Superintendent of Police decides the representation.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
