Nine Councilors of Municipal Committee, Hodal have filed the present writ petition seeking quashing of notice dated 10.3.2015(P-9) issued by the President of the Committee informing about holding of an ordinary meeting of the Committee on 16.3.2015 for conduct of the ordinary business of the Committee.

By referring to Bye Law 4 of the Haryana Municipal Business Bye Laws,1981 providing for atleast seven clear days for fixing such a meeting, it is alleged that the notice requires to be quashed being in violation of the Bye Law 4 since six days' notice was issued.

It is not in dispute that on 16.3.2015 such an ordinary meeting was actually held and a resolution was passed.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel seeks permission to withdraw the present petition to enable the petitioners to

seek appropriate remedy before the authorities under the Haryana
Municipal Act, 1973

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
