Counsel for the parties agree that as a certified copy of the order passed by the District Development and Panchayat Officer-cum-Collector, Sangrur, has been supplied to the petitioner, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of accordingly.

Counsel for the petitioner prays that as the petitioner has filed an appeal accompanied by an application for stay, the Joint Development Commissioner, Punjab, may be directed to consider and decide the application for stay within a fixed period of time and during this period, dispossession of the petitioner may be stayed.

In view of what has been recorded hereinabove, the writ petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly. The Joint Development Commissioner, Punjab, is directed to decide the application for stay filed by the petitioner **within fifteen days** of service being effected upon the respondents. The respondents shall not execute the warrants of possession till the decision of the application for stay.
