The petitioner seeks direction to the respondents to count the entire length of service rendered by him in Indian Navy, Judicial Courts at Kurukshetra and Haryana Education Department, for the purposes of retiral benefits.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of their grievance, the petitioner has served a legal notice, Annexure P-1, however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide the legal notice, Annexure P-1, in terms of the judgment passed by a Division Bench of this Court in *State of Punjab Vs. Malkit Singh, 2011(7) SLR 262*, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
